



## Stuff the Bus Campaign!

**What is Stuff the Bus ?** Communities in Schools of Seattle (CISS) and local businesses are joining forces in the Stuff the Bus school supply drive to provide children in need with backpacks, school supplies, clothing and shoes for the upcoming school year. Our goal this year is to provide these items to 4,000 children.

### How Does it Work?

Participating businesses and community organizations collect supplies in July and August. A school bus will pick up supplies on August 17<sup>th</sup> and the goal is to pack it full of school supplies. At the end of the drive, items are distributed to Seattle schools with the greatest need.

### Why Should I Participate?

Too many of our children start the school year without clothing, shoes, school supplies and other basic items. If education is the key to a better future, this is a great way to provide all students with the tools necessary to succeed in school.

### How Can I Help?
